The goals were developed by the Steering Committee of the Conference. Discussion of the goals is given in the proceedings and the resulting decisions are given in the Resolutions. The results of goal 2 are given in tabular form on page 41 of the proceedings.

1. To review the Summer Minority Program and seek ideas for improvements and new directions for summer program.

2. To get an overall view of the present status of physics at participating schools represented.

3. To identify problems which contribute to the relatively small number of minority students pursuing careers in physics and engineering.

4. To identify problems related to retention at both the undergraduate and graduate levels for minority students.

5. To seek new directions and methods from conference participants which will possibly increase the number of minority scientists.

6. To discuss Fermilab's commitment and level of interest in the proposed recommendations for alleviating the problems identified and the means by which Fermilab can realistically assist in the implementation of them.
